of me, ELIZA EUPHEMIA MAJOR

of Christchurch

in New Zealand, Married Woman.

- 1. I REVOKE all former Wills by me made, AND I APPOINT THE PUBLIC TRUSTEE of New Zealand (hereinafter referred to as "my trustee") to be my Executor and Trustee.
- 2. I GIVE AND BEQUEATH all articles of personal wear or adornment (including jevellery and watches) owned by me at my death to my daughter MAJRGARET EVANGEL HAY should she survive me.
- 3. Should my husband Elliott McKane Major predecease me I GIVE AND BEQUEATH all plate plated goods linen china glass books prints pictures furniture and other articles of household ass or ornamentation (excluding motorears) owned by me at my death to my said daughter MARGARET M/ANGEL MAY should she survive me AND I MARGARET the wish but without intending to create any legally binding trust in this regard that my said daughter shall at her discretion distribute any of the items of my furniture and effects amongst my children.
- 4. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATE the whole of my estate both real and personal of whatsoever nature and wherescover situate not hereinbefore otherwise disposed of unto my trustes. UPON TRUST to pay thereout my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses and all death duty payable in respect of my estate and to stand possessed of the residue for my said husband ELLIOTT MCKANE MAJOR, but should be predecease me then for such of them my children JOHN ELLIOTT MAJOR, PETER BLAIOTT MAJOR, ELLIOTT JAMES RANDLE MAJOR, DAVID ELLIOTT MAJOR and the said MARGARET EVANGEL HAY as are living at my death and if more than one in equal shares PROVIDED HOWEVER AND I DECLARE that should any of my abovenamed children predecease me leaving a child or children living at my death then and in every such case such grandchild or grandchildren of mine shall take and if more than one in equal shares all that the share or interest under this paragraph 4 which his her or their parent would have taken had such parent been living at my death.
- 5. I hereby acknowledge that I am ware that the provisions of the Status of Children Act 1969 may apply to the dispositions of this my will.
